



Scholarship 2011-2012

The Michigan Transition Services Association Scholarship was established in 2000. The association is interested in assisting persons pursuing an education and career in the area of Special Education or Rehabilitation.

Scholarship awards are made to MTSA members at the discretion of the committee established by each regional representative, based on MTSA board recommendations. All awards are made without regard to race, creed, color, sex, religion or national origin.

Requirements

- Students must be enrolled in an accredited college either Junior/Senior level of undergraduate school or a graduate program. The program must be in an area of Special Education or Rehabilitation.
- Students must be an MTSA Member prior to **Dec. 1, 2011**. Membership applications can be found at the MTSA website.
- Students must complete the application and return it to the scholarship chairperson or MTSA regional representative before December 1, **2011**.

Regional representatives will establish a committee to review the applications and select a recipient. Single grants of **\$500** will be awarded to one person from each region. Grant recipients will be notified after **January 21, 2012**.

Recipients will be invited to attend the Spring MTSA Conference **March 16-18, 2012**, with registration and lodging paid by the association. The MTSA Scholarship Chair will disburse funds to individual recipients at the conference.
